Briefly the facts in this appeal are that Ms. Rani Devi, D/O Sh. Gouri Lal, R/O Chhanni Rama, Army Gate, Bye-Pass Road, Jammu moved an application dated 28.11.2014 before the PIO/office of the Deputy Commissioner, Jammu under the Jammu & Kashmir Right to Information Act, 2009 whereunder she sought the following information:

1. Provide the sale deeds and mutations of land transferred by Sh. Surinder Kumar Gupta, S/O Sh. Satya Pal Gupta, R/O Chhanni Rama and names of vendee since 1990 to 2014 who has purchased and area 09 F of shop also.

Feeling aggrieved of inaction on the part of the PIO/Tehsildar, Bahu, Jammu, appellant filed first appeal dated 09.03.2015 before the First Appellate Authority/Deputy Commissioner, Jammu and after that the appellant filed second appeal dated 30.07.2015 before the Commission. The Commission after receiving the second appeal listed the matter for hearing on 18.08.2015. The appellant and the PIO/Tehsildar, Bahu Jammu were present during the course of proceedings. The PIO submitted before the Commission that the information as available in the office record stands already furnished to the information seeker. However, the information seeker alleged that the information provided to her is incomplete and not as per the RTI application and requested the Commission that she may be allowed an opportunity to inspect the office record. The PIO assured the Commission that he will provide her an adequate opportunity for inspection of record and also the revised information in case requested by the information seeker.

In view of the aforesaid facts, the PIO/Tehsildar, Bahu Jammu is hereby directed to allow the appellant an opportunity to inspect the record in his office on a working day during office hours and provide her requisite/revised information as per the office record, if any requested by the information seeker. The parties are at liberty to settle the date and time for inspection of record which may be convenient to them.

The appeal is accordingly disposed of.

Notice of this decision be given free of cost to the parties.
