Brief facts of the case are the appellant filed Second Appeal before the Commission on 18.04.2016 stating that no response has been given to the RTI application dated 23.12.2015 by PIO, Government Medical College, Jammu. That he filed First Appeal dated 10.03.2016 before FAA in which the FAA has furnished the reply of query No. (a) stating that the Doctor was appointed at Asstt. Surgeon under SRO 384 in Emergency GMC Hospital Jammu, but has not furnished the certified copy of the duty roster of the said Dr. Sanjeev Parihar s/o Girdhari Lal w.e.f. 01.04.2014 to 15.04.2014.

Dr. Uttam Singh, Deputy Medical Superintendent, GMC Jammu and appellant Mr. Pardeep Singh Jamwal attended the hearing at Jammu office.

Second Appeal has been filed on the ground that certified copy of duty roaster of Dr. Sajeev Parishar s/o Girdhar Lal w.e.f. 01.04.2014 to 15.04.2014 has not been provided to him. Respondent submitted that he

has brought duty roaster for the said period along with him and same shall be provided to the appellant at the conclusion of the hearing.

Since information sought has now been provided, the appeal filed before the Commission is disposed of. It has however, been observed that there is no evidence brought on record that RTI application has been responded to by the PIO GMC, Jammu. The appellant has only enclosed reply of FAA dated 05.04.2016 stating that MS GMC Jammu has forwarded copy of letter dated 30.11.2015. However, this reply is not related to the present RTI application dated 26.12.2015.

PIO GMC Jammu has not filed reply/counter statement to the appeal, as was directed by the Commission and therefore prima-facie is liable for initiation of action under Section 17 of the Act.

Accordingly, PIO GMC Jammu is directed to explain within two weeks as to why proceedings under Section 17 of J&K RTI Act, 2009 shall not initiated for delay in disposing of the RTI application.

Appeal disposed of with above directions.
