**I. Brief facts of the case.**

The complainant had filed an RTI application dated 02-04-2016, with PIO, JKSRTC, Rail Head, Jammu seeking information on 04 points under section 6 of J&K RTI Act, 2009. The PIO did not dispose of the RTI application. As such, the complainant preferred 1<sup>st</sup> appeal with the concerned First Appellate Authority (FAA) on 29-09-2016. The FAA vide communication dated 06-10-2016 asked the General Manager (Adm) to provide the information to the complainant. However, the complainant, was not provided the requisite information by the respondents. The inaction of the PIO constrained the complainant to approach the Commission under

section 15 of the J&K RTI Act, 2009 with the prayer to impose penalty and take action against the PIO for his failure to provide information and for violation of provisions of the Act.

## **II. Proceedings before the Commission.**

The complaint came up for hearing before the Commission on 20-04-2017. The hearing was attended by the complainant. During the hearing, the complainant stated that she has now received all the requisite information asked for by her and there was nothing pending and requested for withdrawal of the complaint. She submitted a written application in support of her plea which was taken on record.

## **III. Decision:**

***In view of the submission made by the complainant the Commission finds no legal hitch in acceding to the plea of the complainant for withdrawal of instant complaint. However, the complainant is debarred from filing complaint/2<sup>nd</sup> appeal in future on the same RTI application.***

***Accordingly, the complaint is dismissed as withdrawn.***
