**Brief Facts:**

This is a second appeal filed under section 16 (4) of the J&K Right to Information Act, 2009 in the J&K State Information Commission by one Sh. Sikander Singh, S/o. Sh. Kaka Singh, VPO: Hamirpur, Sidhar Tehsil: Khour, District: Jammu-181203 on 01.03.2017 against the order of the

FAA/Joint Director (SSA), Directorate of School Education, Jammu passed on 07.02.2017.

**Proceedings:**

The case was listed for hearing on 25.05.2017 on which date the Commission observed that since the appellant was not satisfied with the information provided, a fresh set of information in terms of his RTI application may be given to him.

The case was again listed today on 13.06.2017. PIO/Sh. Ram Pal, Chief Education Officer, Jammu, Sh. Dev Raj, ZEO, Khour and Sh. Amit Gupta (on behalf of FAA) attended the hearing. The appellant also attended. During hearing the appellant admitted that he has not sought any specific document and he had various grievances against the department, as such raised various queries in his RTI application.

**Decision/Directions:**

The Commission after hearing the parties and going through the papers on record observed that the appellant has sought information in the form of questionnaire consisting of 08 queries which does not seek any tangible information but is in the nature of a questionnaire seeking opinions which have not been expressed so far and intended action not taken yet. The queries do not fit into the definition of information under section 2(d) of the J&K RTI Act, 2009. However, the ZEO, Khour is directed to go through the RTI application of the appellant carefully and dispose of

the same in terms of the RTI Act wherever and to whatever extent it is found applicable.

The second appeal is accordingly disposed of.
