Brief facts:

The brief facts of this 2nd appeal are that the appellant Sh. Mohd. Sadiq Makroo had sought information from the PIO/Secretary LAWDA through an RTI application dated 12.10.2017. In the 2nd appeal filed before the Commission, the

appellant has represented that neither the PIO nor the FAA of LAWDA provided him full information that he had sought and that is why he has filed the 2nd appeal before the Commission.

The 2nd appeal last came up for hearing on 09.02.2018 at Srinagar, which was attended by the representative of the appellant Sh. Gh. Mohammad Makroo, Dr. Abdul Hafiz, FAA/V.C. LAWDA and Mr. Shabir Ahmad, Law Officer, LAWDA. The said hearing was adjourned with directions to LAWDA to provide the balance information and in respect of which VC LAWDA also gave the assurance that the balance information will be got provided to the appellant.

The first 60 days since the date of filing of this 2nd appeal expired on 26.02.2018. But in view of the need for conduct of more hearings for appropriate and judicious disposal of the appeal, the time period for disposal was extended by another 60 days in terms of proviso to Sub-section-11 of Section-16 of the J&K RTI Act, 2009.

The appeal came up for hearing again today on 10.04.2018 at Srinagar, which was attended by Ms Sumara Shamim PIO/Secretary LAWDA and Mr. Mohammad Syed Khan, Collector

Land Acquisition, LAWDA. However, the appellant was not present personally nor through his representative. The PIO informed that the remaining information has already been sent to the appellant.

In view of the submission of the PIO that the remaining information had already been sent to the appellant, this appeal is accordingly disposed of with no further directions. The VC, LAWDA had given an assurance during the earlier hearing that he will continue to make efforts to have the dispute between the appellant and another party resolved so that there is no occasion for such RTIs. That may be done if not already done.
