**Final Order**  
**(Complaint)**

**Brief Facts:**

This is a complaint filed under section 15 of the J&K RTI Act, 2009 (Act for short) by Sh. Avinash Razdan, S/o. Lt. Sh. Mohan Lal Razdan, R/o 783, Subash Nagar, Jammu on 26.04.2017 inter alia alleging that the APIO/Deputy Registrar (Admin), J&K High Court had wrongly informed the appellant for appearing in two First Appeals, in back dates and sent the information for appearance in another First Appeal at a short notice of two hours, without giving him an opportunity by violating the High Court (Right to Information) Rules, 2014.

## **Proceedings:**

In compliance to the notice of the Commission dated: 16.09.2017, the hearing was attended by the Complainant. None appeared on behalf of the Respondent.

The Commission perused the reply of the APIO/Sh. Satish Parihar, Deputy Registrar (Admn.) High Court of J&K, Jammu Wing wherein, he has stated that the notice of the Commission dated: 16.09.2017 had been wrongly issued to him, because the complaint does not pertain to him but pertains to APIO, Main wing of the Hon'ble High Court at present Jammu. The Commission has perused the allegations made by the complainant in the complaint about the conduct of the APIO while dealing with the complainant's First Appeals before the FAA of the Hon'ble High Court.

## **Directions:**

**The complaint does not fall within the purview of section 15 of the J&K RTI Act, 2009 as there is no reference to his work as PIO or APIO under the RTI Act. It pertains to the work of the designated APIO as an officer of the Hon'ble High Court assisting the FAA in fixing hearings etc. It will be appropriate to refer this complaint to the FAA/Registrar General, High Court of J&K at Jammu for disposal under Law and Rules.**

With these directions the complaint is disposed of.
