**FINAL ORDER**

The applicant Shri Rashu Kanna filed RTI application with Public Information Officer/ Dy. SP (Hqrs), Jammu on 19-09-2016 seeking information on 17 points. The PIO furnished the information to the applicant on 07-10-2016. The PIO furnished additional information to the applicant on 16-02-2017. Terming the

information incomplete, the applicant filed 1<sup>st</sup> appeal with FAA/Suptd. of Police (Hqrs.), Jammu on 07-03-2017. As the FAA failed to dispose of the 1<sup>st</sup> appeal, the applicant filed 2<sup>nd</sup> appeal before the SIC on 29-05-2017, which was admitted by the Commission for hearing on 28-12-2017 after making the appellant to remove procedural deficiencies.

**Proceedings before the SIC:** The appeal came up for hearing before the SIC on 12-02-2018. The hearing was attended by the appellant as well as the PIO. The PIO also filed a counter statement saying that the information has been provided to the appellant. The appellant, however, submitted that the information provided by the PIO was incomplete and evasive. He also submitted that the issues raised by him in his RTI application actually pertained to Nagrota Police Station and therefore, SDPO, Nagrota and SHO, Nagrota should be directed to appear before the Commission for answering the queries. The hearing was accordingly adjourned and the PIO was directed to inform SDPO, Nagrota and SHO, Nagrota to attend the next hearing.

The appeal again came up for hearing on 03-04-2018. Besides the appellant, the hearing was attended by PIO and SHO, Nagrota. The respondents submitted that complete information was provided to the appellant by the FAA, while disposing of his 1<sup>st</sup> appeal on 21-02-2017. A copy of the information furnished to the appellant was submitted by the PIO to the Commission. After hearing the parties and going through the reply furnished to the appellant, the Commission directed the PIO to provide revised information to the appellant in respect of point Nos 2, 5 and 8 of his RTI application.

The rest of the information had already been provided to the appellant on 21-02-2017.

The appeal finally came up for hearing before the Commission on 23-04-2018. The PIO informed that the appellant has not specified the issue about which he seeks action taken report in point No. 2 of his application. In response to point No. 5, the PIO submitted that no complaint has been filed by Mrs. Suneelma Kanna on 2<sup>nd</sup> July, 2016 as per the records of Police Station, Nagrota. In response to point No. 8 of the RTI application, the PIO submitted that no MLC report dated 25<sup>th</sup> July, 2016 was available in the records of Police Station, Nagrota as no such MLC has been conducted. However, the appellant wanted the said information in writing and in a proper format. The PIO agreed to provide revised reply to points 2, 5 and 8 of his RTI application within a period of 15 days.

**Decision:**

As most of the information sought by the appellant has been furnished to him and the PIO has assured to provide revised left-out information in respect of points 2, 5 and 8 within a period of 15 days, there is no point in keeping this appeal on board. The appeal is accordingly disposed of with a direction to the PIO to provide revised reply to the appellant in respect to points 2, 5 and 8 within a period of 15 days from the receipt of this order.
