This appeal has arisen out the RTI application dated 18.10.2018 filed by Mr. Sh. Zakir Hussain before PIO/Dy. Chief Medical officer, Kargil seeking information on five points as mentioned in the said RTI application. Not satisfied with the information provided by the PIO, the applicant filed First Appeal before the FAA/CMO Kargil on 15.12.2017. Again aggrieved by the disposal of the FAA, the appellant filed the 2nd appeal before the Commission on 27.04.2018 requesting therein that the

respondents be directed to provide him the requisite information as sought by him vide his RTI application dated 18.10.2017.

The appeal came up for hearing before the Commission today on 19.07.2017. Mr. Dr. Muhammad Afzal, Dy. CMO Kargil and appellant Sh. Zakir Hussain attended the hearing at NIC Office Kargil but could not be contacted through video conferencing in view of failure of net facility in Kargil and as such, the parties were heard through voice call. The PIO/Dy. CMO, Kargil informed that requisite information has been provided to the information seeker vide letter No.CMO-K/Actts-RTI/2017/9070-72 Dated 26.12.2017. Although the appellant acknowledged the receipt of information but he expressed his dis-satisfaction over the information provided to him and also submitted that no information was provided in respect of Point (e) of his basic RTI application. On being asked by the Commission as to how the information relating to points (a), (b), (c) and (d) as provided by the PIO on 26-12-2017 was unsatisfactory, the appellant could not offer any tangible description. The reply furnished by the PIO was gone through and the Commission could not find any deficiency viz a viz the

queries raised by the appellant in his RTI application. The non-satisfaction expressed by the appellant in respect of reply to points (a) to (d) was found to be unfounded by the Commission. However, the PIO has not replied point (e) of the RTI application and the PIO was accordingly directed to furnish the information to the appellant as regards point (e) of the RTI application.

Since the PIO has furnished all the information to the appellant except point (e) of the RTI request, this appeal is disposed of with a direction to the PIO/CMO Kargil to provide the left out information in respect of point (e) of the RTI application to the appellant within a period of 10 days from the date of receipt of this order.
