Brief Facts:

The present appeal has arisen out of RTI application dated: 05.03.2018 filed by the applicant Sh. Harinder Pal Singh, R/o. 347-Shastri Nagar, Jammu seeking information from the ACD, Jammu whether RDD can execute works in the area of Jammu Municipal Corporation, whether funds have been released for Shastri Nagar Park under CDF by MLC Vikram Randhawa and whether estimates and other documents have been submitted for release of CDF for the said Park. The ACD, Jammu transferred the RTI application to PIO/BDO, Satwari on 08.02.2018 for providing the information to the applicant directly. The applicant, however, filed First Appeal with ACD, Jammu on 13.03.2018 submitting that the PIO has not provided any information to him. Finally, the applicant filed second appeal before the State Information Commission on

11.05.2018 on the ground that the PIO has not provided any information to him and also that FAA has not disposed of the First Appeal filed by him.

Proceedings:

The appeal came up for hearing before the Commission today on 30.08.2018. Sh. Mudasir Latief, FAA/ACD, Jammu and the appellant were present during the hearing. The FAA submitted that at present no BDO has been posed in Block Satwari. He, however, informed that the information sought by the applicant was sent to him through registered post. However, the applicant submitted that he has not received any information from the PIO. At this stage, the FAA submitted that a copy of the information sent to the appellant was available with him and he can furnish the same to the appellant during the course of hearing. Accordingly, the FAA was directed to handover the copy of the information to the appellant and the same was done by the FAA during the hearing itself.

Decision:

The appeal is accordingly disposed of. In case the appellant is not satisfied with the information so provided by the FAA during the course of hearing, he shall have the liberty to file a complaint before the Commission under section 15 of the Act.
