BRIEF FACTS:

The present appeal has arisen out of RTI application dated 03-11-2017 filed by the appellant Shri Vipin Sharma with PIO/Women and Child Development, Bahu Plaza, Jammu seeking information regarding State/Central schemes being implemented by Project Officer, ICDS Trikuta Nagar, names, parentage and address of beneficiaries under the said scheme and also the names and address of Incharge and

other workers drawing remuneration from different centers under the Project Officer, Trikota Nagar. As the PIO failed to provide the information to the appellant, he filed first appeal with Director, ICDS, Jammu/FAA on 07-12-2017. Finally, the appellant filed second appeal with the State Information Commission on 23-04-2018 which was registered by the Commission on 02-05-2018.

The appeal came up for hearing before the Commission today on 27-08-2018. The appellant as well as FAA/Joint Director, ICDS Department, Jammu Mr. Pritam Lal and PIO/Deputy Director, ICDS Department, Jammu Mrs Deepika Rana were present during the hearing. The appellant submitted that he has not received the information from the PIO. However, the FAA/PIO have informed the Commission that the information has already been furnished to the appellant through post. However, in case the appellant seeks another copy of the information, the same is available with the FAA and can be handed over to him during the hearing. Accordingly, the FAA and PIO were directed to handover a copy of the information to the appellant which they did. In the said information, the list of beneficiaries sought by the appellant in point No. 2 of his RTI application and also names

of the officers/workers drawing remuneration from different centers under the Project Officer, Trikota Nagar sought by him in point No. 3 of the RTI application has been furnished to the appellant. However, in respect of point No. 1, the appellant has been informed that the said information was not available with the CDPO or Project Officer as the said officers are not authorized to implement any scheme directly and the same is being done at the highest administrative level. The Project Officer also informed that there were 25 beneficiaries for each Anganwadi center and a complete list of beneficiaries has been provided to the appellant. The Project Officer also informed that no construction activity is being carried out by the department as all the Anganwadi centers are housed in the hired buildings. Besides no purchases have been made in respect of nutrition items for last two years. However, the State Level Procurement Committee has finalized a rate contract for the current year for procurement of nutrition items like peas, chana, sugar and Haldi. Therefore, the office of CDPO or the Project Officer does not procure or purchase any nutrition item at their level.

The appellant expressed his satisfaction with the information so provided by the Project Officer during the

course of hearing. Since the appellant has received the information as sought by him through his RTI application, the appeal is accordingly disposed of.
